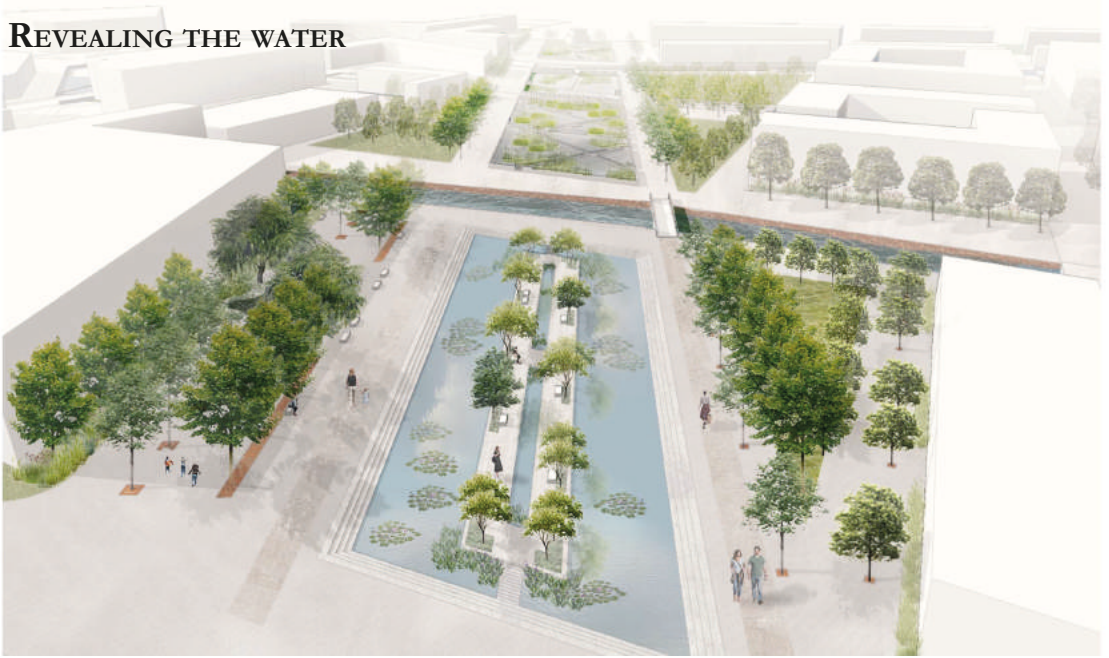


REVEALING THE WATER

This project explores the idea of how to reveal the water by:

- reclaiming greywater
- recycle rainwater
- restore the water in the canal

Water is the core basis for human life moreover, the infrastructure for transporting and treating water forms the foundation of urban settlement. Yet the development of infrastructural systems has removed the experience of water from the urban realm and produced an ever-expanding but invisibly maintained network sustaining everyday life.

This project addresses the qualities of infrastructure and seeks to uncover its potential in enriching the experience of urban realm it also explores how we can improve the freshwater quality.

The project is an exploration of a water treatment environment as a place of **recreation, education** and **enhanced biodiversity**. By applying techniques of biological water treatment, the project seeks to challenge the way water and wastewater is perceived and treated today.
